



2. CAREER UPGRADE WITH EXECUTIVE DIPLOMA & GRADUATION

Career Upgrade with Executive Diploma Programme or shortly known as CUEDIP was a SEDIC funded program. It was targeted for 100 Indian Women in the B40 category. Those participating were either employed or doing their own business and yearning for paper qualification as a form of recognition and to move forward.



The motto for this programme was "STAND OUT AND SHINE" and the objectives were to:

- provide paper qualification to those who do not have any.
- help them chart their career pathway and identify gaps
- provide them with fundamental de velopment training that is necessary to prepare them for a career upgrade or career change.
- guide and mentor them to achieve their career goals
- follow up on their progress
- prepare them for interviews and new job opportunities





The Executive Diploma in Ad ninistration is awarded by International Professional Managers' Association in UK (IPMA, UK). IPMA (UK) is a body that is renowned not only in UK but also in Malaysia, including HRDF. The programmes' materials, assignments and assessments were prevalidated by IPMA (UK). All those who graduate with IPMA (UK) are entitled to free membership in IPMA and may use the letters "MPMA" behind their name.

Batch 1 and 2 consisted of 50 pax from Wilayah Persekutuan and Selangor. The training were conducted mostly in Brickfield Asia College, PJ Campus, from Jan – June 2018. Batch 3 for Perak consisted of 25 pax and the training were conducted mostly in JSS Tailoring Academy from July – Sep 2018 and batch 4 for Johor was conducted from Aug – Nov 2018, mostly in MIC Hall in Taman Nesa.



Ongoing assignments were given for each module. At the end of the 10 modules, ONE day final competence assessment was conducted to evaluate them. Those who did not complete the CUEDIP or did not attend the final assessment were not eligible to graduate. Upon completion of final assessment, participants were divided into groups and asked to undertake projects. The purpose is to coach and mentor them, so that they could practice whatever learnt. This will also help them to build their own confidence.




















3. REACH OUT TO OTHER STATES
